- The Stuttering Program is one of the many services offered through the Center for Disability Services Outpatient Therapy Program.
- The Stuttering Program provides assessment and treatment for children, adolescents, and adults who stutter.
- The Stuttering Program is staffed by a Licensed Speech-Language Pathologist with extensive personal and professional knowledge in the area of stuttering.

What kind of treatment & assistance is available through the Stuttering Program?

- The Stuttering Program offers diagnosis and treatment designed to help people who stutter get better at life.
- Treatment is designed to meet the specific needs of each individual who stutters.
- A family-centered approach is used to help young children who stutter.
- The Stuttering Program offers education and support for people who stutter, their families, teachers, and other professionals as appropriate.

What payment options does the Stuttering Program offer?

- We accept most major insurances. However, obtaining insurance coverage for stuttering therapy can be a challenge. Office staff will assist families when trying to navigate this process.
- The Stuttering Program offers private pay options.
- The Stuttering Program offers services Covered and approved through the Committee on Preschool Special Education (CPSE) and Early Intervention (EI).
- We also contract with School Districts for Individual Student Consultations.
