Langan school is committed to open and on-going communication with families. We would like to inform you that the administration of Kevin G Langan School has been working with the local Departments of Health in contact tracing our most resent positive cases. Today we have been made aware of a positive staff at Albany CloverPatch. This staff has not been in any other building or on any other school grounds.

DOH will reach out to all individuals who have had contact and advise them to quarantine. Langan School has been in contact with all students and staff affected by this most recent positive case.

Currently Glenville CloverPatch and Albany Langan Schools will remain open for in-person instruction.

- At this time the Albany Langan afterschool program will be closed until 1/14/21 and re-open 1/19/21.
- Albany CloverPatch is operating completely remote until 1/19/21
- Langan at Prospect Center will be operating completely remote until 1/19/21.
- Albany Langan School is operating with reduced classrooms until 1/19/21.

Teachers and therapist will provide virtual education and services during this time. Langan School has been working with school districts throughout this school year to ensure that students have adequate equipment to participate in virtual learning. We encourage you to reach out to your students' teacher if you are in need of any additional resources or have any concerns.

Due to the requirements of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPPA) we cannot disclose any personal information about the staff who tested positive or those that have been in contact with this staff person. The staff has been placed on mandatory quarantine and will remain there for a period of 14 days before returning to school.
