Center for Disability Services is committed to open and on-going communication with families. We would like to inform you that the administrators of education division have been working with the local Departments of Health in contact tracing our most recent positive case.

We have been made aware of one positive students and one positive staff at Langan School at Prospect Center. This student and staff member were not in any other buildings.

DOH will reach out to all individuals who have had contact and will advise them to quarantine. We have been in contact with all families and staff affected by this most recent positive case.

Effective November 29, 2021 Glenville and Albany CloverPatch, Albany Langan, and Langan at Prospect Schools will remain open for in-person instruction.

Due to the most recent staff and student positives;

Langan at Prospect will be operating with one classroom on hybrid instruction. Students and staff from this classroom will be returning for in-person instruction on 12/7/21.

Teachers and therapists will provide virtual instruction and services during this time. CloverPatch and Langan School have been working with school districts throughout this school year to ensure that students have adequate equipment to participate in virtual learning. We encourage you to reach out to your students' teacher if you are in need of any additional resources or have any concerns.

Due to the requirements of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPPA) we cannot disclose any personal information about the staff or student who tested positive or those that have been in contact with them.

Those involved, **who are not vaccinated**, have been placed on mandatory quarantine and will remain there for a period of 10 days before returning to school.
