Langan school is committed to open and on-going communication with families. We would like to inform you that the administration of Kevin G Langan School has been working with the local Departments of Health in contact tracing our most recent positive student cases. Today we have been made aware of a positive student at Albany Langan after school program. This student has not been in any other building or on any other school grounds. We have also been informed that over the holiday break a student who attends our Albany Langan school tested positive. The student has not been back to school since the holiday recess and therefore no contact tracing is needed.

DOH will reach out to all individuals who have had contact and advise them to quarantine. Langan School has been in contact with all students and staff affected by this most recent positive case.

Currently Glenville and Albany CloverPatch, Prospect School, and Albany Langan Schools will remain open for in-person instruction. At this time the Albany Langan afterschool program will be closed until 1/13/2021 and will reopen on 1/19/2021. Teachers and therapist will provide virtual education and services during this time. Langan School has been working with school districts throughout this school year to ensure that students have adequate equipment to participate in virtual learning. We encourage you to reach out to your students' teacher if you are in need of any additional resources or have any concerns.

Due to the requirements of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPPA) we cannot disclose any personal information about the staff who tested positive or those that have been in contact with this staff person. The staff has been placed on mandatory quarantine and will remain there for a period of 14 days before returning to school.
